The way to Department of Mathematical Sciences, KAIST, Daejeon, Korea. (The lecture room is #1501 in the building E6.)

From Incheon International Airport to Daejeon (It reads DAYJON. 대전 in Korean)

(KAIST main campus is in Daejeon, 140 kilometers (90 miles) south of Seoul.)

1. There is one simple way to travel from Incheon airport to KAIST. That is Airport Limousine bus.

Bus boarding place in Incheon International Airport: Bus stop #8B. After you getting out of the building, please find a ticket box on the street. Purchase a ticket to Daejeon(대전). (It costs about 25,000Korean won (about 25USD), cash or credit cards.) Then, go to your bus stop **#8B**, which is at a half way across the street, in a bus stop island. Please check if the bus is going to Daejeon.

The bus leaves the airport at regular intervals (about 3 times an hour). **Your stop is the very first one which is called "Lotte Hotel" stop.** It takes about 2.5 hours. If you miss your stop, don't worry. Take the next one, which is equally okay. The bus is spacious and comfortable.

2. Then, take a Taxi to KAIST. The cost for the taxi ride is around 3,000 Korean Won (about 3 USD) and takes about 10 minutes. You may show the following to your Taxi Driver.

(Translation: I am going to KAIST. Take the main gate of KAIST. Then, turn right immediately. Then go to E6 as in the following figure.)
